General Eligibility for the Applicants

Note: -

Following the guidelines of UGC as published in UGC model Curriculum 2001 and 2016, certain notion be cleared. At S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY, from the domain of Visual Art only drawing and painting program is being taught, as of now. This program is a professional program and hence the criterions for application for the course are also limited. There are certain university who offer BA in drawing and painting a general course (as defined by the model curriculum guidelines). They are not eligible for the professional course. UGC also has emphasized on campus full time learning program and hence the program is not available for the distance mode/ off campus mode.

Who can apply?

Candidates:

- 1. **Students having 10+2+4** format of BVA/BFA painting from UGC recognized University with minimum of higher second class at bachelor's degree
- 2. **Old MA** Drawing and Painting **of S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY** students, wishing for class improvement or want to learn a new programme.
- 3. Who have cleared all the courses in drawing and painting at graduate level and possess the degree in BFA/ BVA with drawing and painting from UGC recognized University. (Students can check the list of recognized universities from the UGC site.)
- 4. The students who have successfully cleared BFA/BVA in **Applied Arts with Illustration** in 1st class from the UGC recognized University can apply. Such applicants should have earned 24 credits/ 600 marks from their entire degree program in drawing based subjects to be eligible to seek admission at MVA in drawing and painting of S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY, for Mural/ Creative Painting/ Portraiture.
- 5. **For Mural,** Students who have done BFA/BVA **in Sculpture** with 1st class from **any UGC recognized University**. Such applicants should have earned at-least **24 credits/600 marks** from their entire degree program in drawing based subjects to be eligible to seek admission at MVA in drawing and painting of S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY.
- 6. The students who have successfully cleared BFA/BVA in Applied Arts other than Illustration in 1st class from the UGC recognized University can apply. Such applicants should have earned 24 credits/ 600 marks from their entire degree program in drawing based subjects to be eligible to seek admission at MVA in drawing and painting of S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY, for Creative Painting/ Portraiture.
- 7. Students, who have **done last year BVA from S.N.D.T. WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY** course after doing graduating diploma of Maharashtra state govt. or any other state govt. **in**

fine arts in the 10+5 format with two year English, will be eligible to apply for MVA programme.

Who is not eligible?

- 1. Since UGC has emphasized on **fulltime on campus** programmes for visual art. Anyone who has such a degree as of distance mode cannot apply.
- 2. **Bridge course** in the same domain as that of visual art is also not recommended by UGC especially for practical course. Students who have done one year bridge course after doing graduating diploma of Maharashtra state govt. or any other state govt. in the 10+5 format are not eligible.

Who is entitled to appear for the exams each semester?

- 1. The students who have cleared their internal continuous practical assessment and submission of theory assignment as laid out in the programme.
- 2. Who has paid their all fees
- 3. Who has submitted their relevant documents to the departments ,like exam form , migration certificate, leaving certificate or any document that the office or department asks for.
- 4. For the last, 4th Semester no ATKT in any course should be there with the students.
- 5. Have fulfilled their mandatory attendance of 75%. (Medical cases may be excused, provided that they submitted a medical certificate of illness and certificate of fitness).

ELGIBILITY RULES

FOR CREATIVE PAINTING

- i. The students must show an aptitude towards this field.
- ii. The students must have this course in her bachelor degree program.
- iii. The students can have freedom of only four credits to opt from the other course and they can also avail the four credits from the course other than their own specialization in the first and second semester.
- iv. She should secure at least 50% in her interview. Fifty percentage will be taken from the final year of the graduation and 50% will be taken from the interview. If the candidate secures 50% from the aggregate then she will be admitted to creative painting specialization
- v.The student who has applied art with illustration as her specialization at the bachelor degree program may seek admission to this programme provided her performance and aptitude meets the requirement of the programme, and they had Aesthetics and History of Art at their degree and have appeared the exam for the same.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

FOR ALL THE SPECIALZATION

- The available seats are five for each specialization
- Every Candidate for M.V.A. Post degree in Painting has to get registered as a Post Graduate student of S.N.D.T. Women's University, by applying online.
- Admission will be based purely on the merit of Candidate's Qualification & performance at the interview conducted by the department of drawing and painting of S.N.D.T. Women's University on a stipulated date.
- Total 100 marks will be considered for qualification at graduate level examination & the interview with equal weight age.
- 50% out of the total percentage & 50 marks for the interview. The candidate must obtain at least 25 marks (50%) to qualify in interview. The panel for interview will be comprised of respective Head of the department with the colleague, candidate from reservation, and a subject expert.
- After the interview the list of eligible candidate will be displayed and the students will have to pay the fees according to the time and date noted in the notice issued by the head of the department.
- Students failing to do so the admission will be given to the immediate next student.
- The students seeking admission after the interview has been already conducted will not get admission in the specialization of their choice but in the specialization where the seats are available and if the candidate agrees to the decision.
- For CBCS only post degree regular students can apply.
