

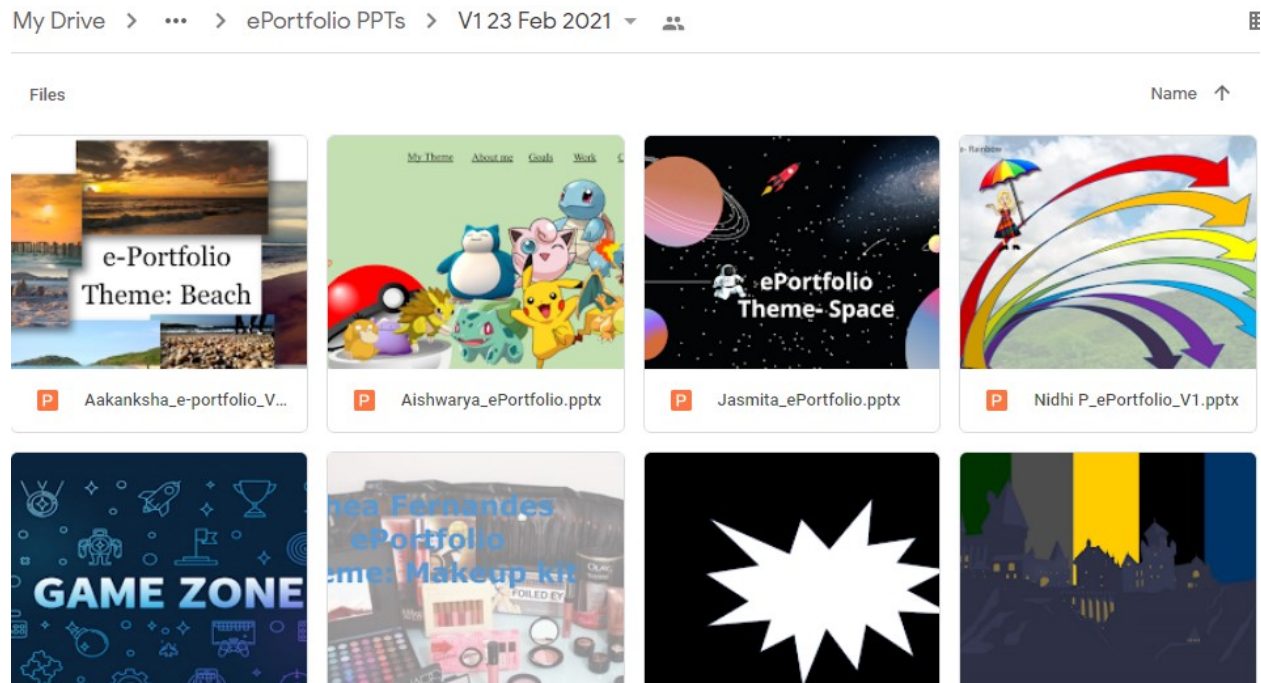

The teacher can gather students together for a collaborative online session or post an asynchronous activity. It has different sections 1. Quickfire: The teacher can create planned quiz with multiple question formats 2. Clip: It turns public video into live chat Teachers can plan an activity from any of these sections and choose to save and launch it in live class or post it as an assignment. Teachers can review, assess, and give feedback.
Samiksha Desai	Edpuzzle	EdPuzzle is a free assessment-centered tool that allows teachers and students to create interactive online videos by embedding either open-ended or multiple-choice questions, audio notes, audio tracks, or comments on a video. EdPuzzle helps teachers to run a flipped classroom; assign videos for homework. EdPuzzle enables teachers to keep track of how many students watched the video, what percentage of the video students watched, when they watched it, what questions in the video students answered right or wrong.

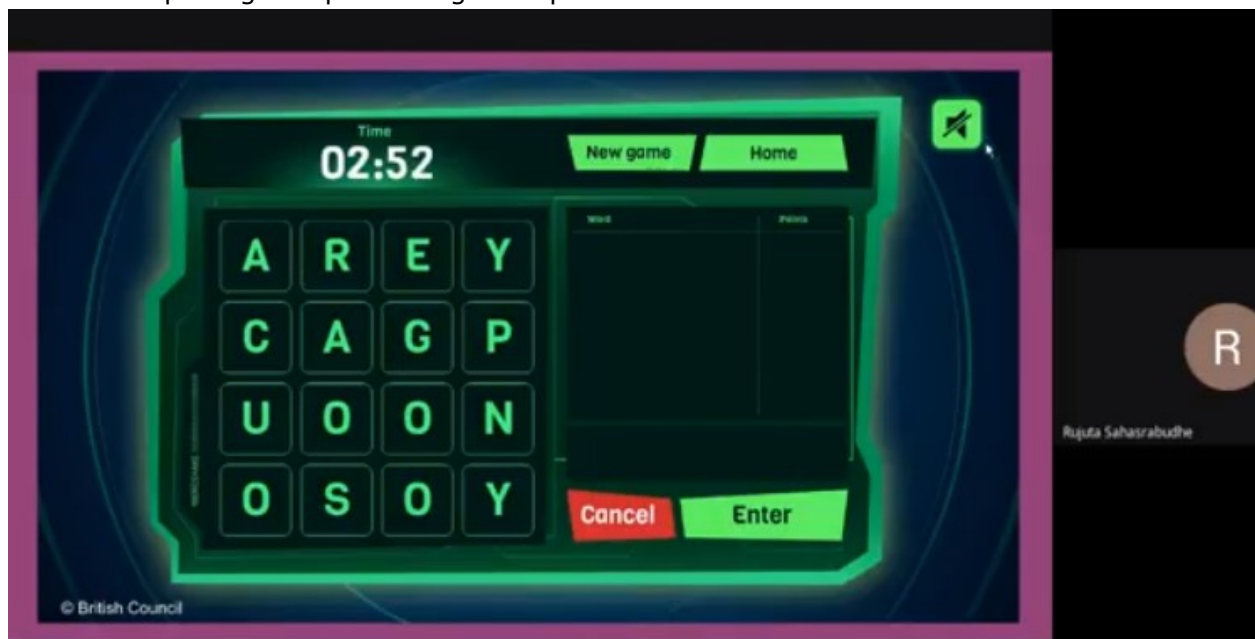

ePortfolio is a comprehensive evaluation tools used. Students design ePortfolio to compile their assignments during the last semester.



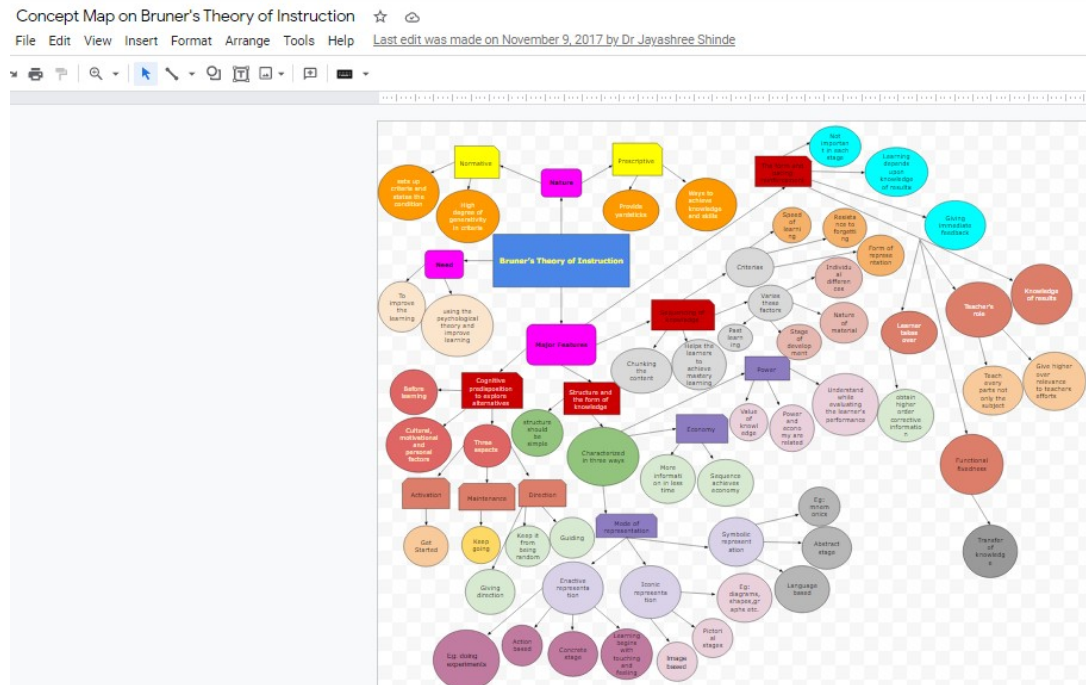
Student presentations are used across the disciplines. Students presented their work even in online mode during the pandemic.

Students exploring and presenting examples online.

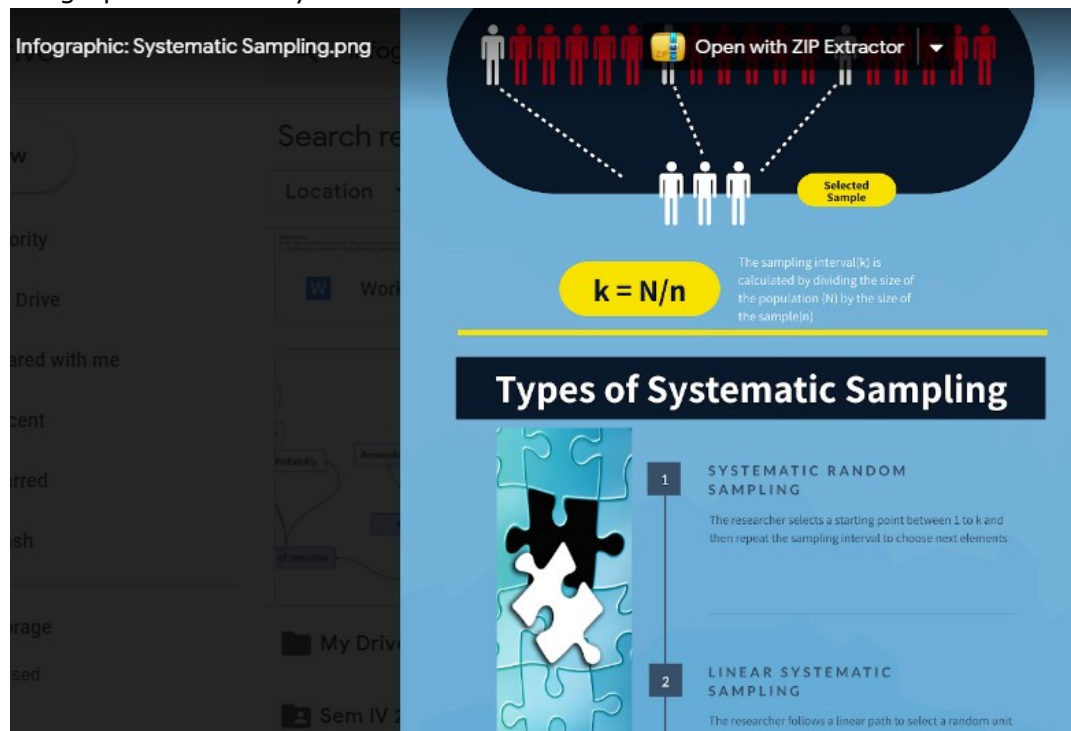


Instead of merely giving paper-pencil tests, students are told to design visual presentations of the acquired knowledge such as concept-maps and mind-maps for assignments: submissions.
