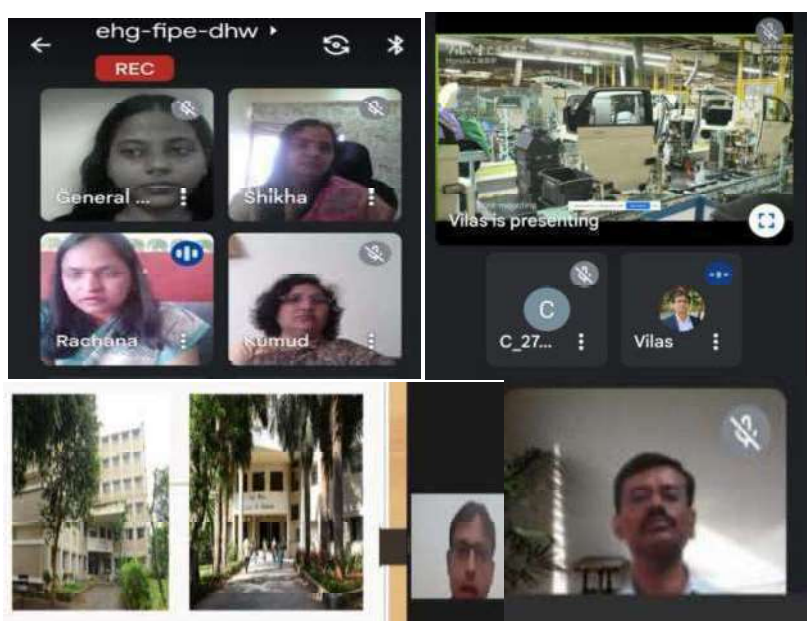

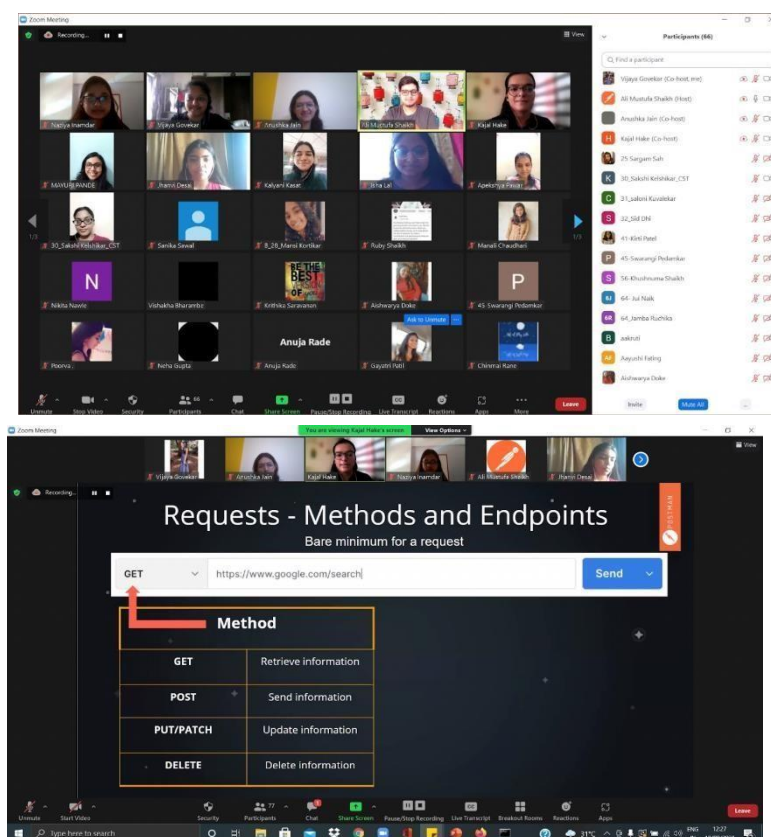
## Webinar on basics of Web Development

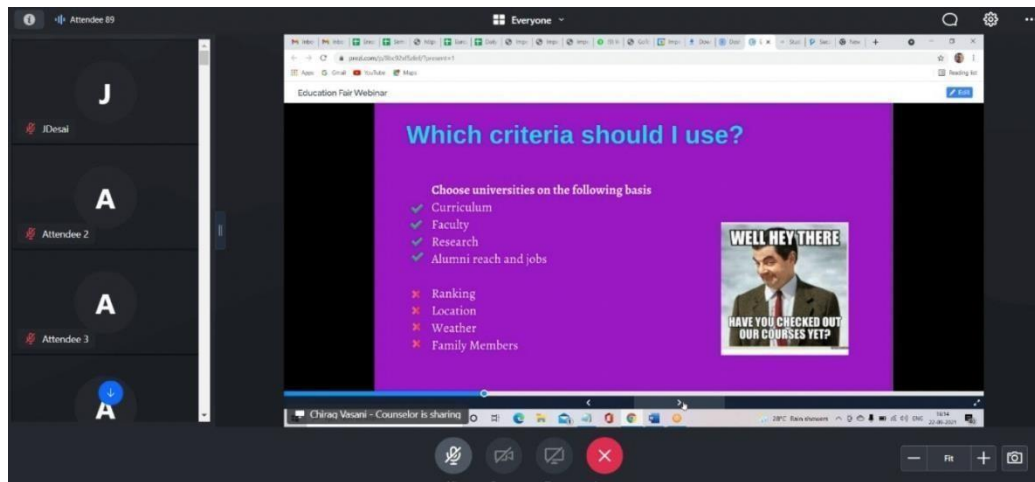
## APIs 101 with Postman
