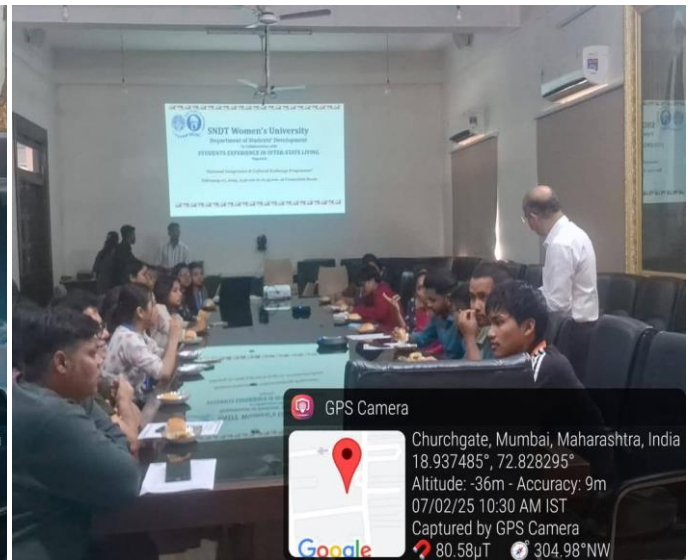
As part of this initiative, 30 student delegates from North East India visited various institutions, colleges, dignitaries,
