Selected participants from Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Goa.

Winners from University round will represent their region at the National Level.

3) Phase II (Final round) - National Level

Venue: Nagpur Vidhan Sabha (Maharashtra Legislative Assembly)

Format: Actual Parliamentary-style debate and deliberation.

Month: January 2026

Finalists from all regions across India will participate and deliberate on environmental policy and sustainability issues.
